**Tunis-Carthage-Sbeitla-Chott-Matmata-Djerba-El Jem**

**SAT DAY 01 ARRIVE TUNIS** On arrival at Tunis Airport you shall be transferred to your hotel for the following two nights stay. (D)

**SUN DAY 02 TUNIS-CARTHAGE-SIDI BOU SAID** Today visit the Bardo Museum, famous for its impressive collection of mosaics, then walk through the colourful souks of the ancient medina. After lunch depart for Carthage, founded by the Phoenicians in the 9th Century BC. Visit the Moorish village of Sidi Bou Said with its whitewashed buildings. Dinner and overnight. (BLD)

**MON DAY 03 TUNIS-KAIROUAN—SBEITLA-TOZEUR** After breakfast drive to Kairouan, the first religious capital of the Moslem world. See the Aghlabite Ponds, and walk through the old medina with its souks, famous carpet shops and the Great Mosque. Continue to Sbeitla and lunch at a local restaurant. Visit the Sbeitla archaeological site. Travel to Gafsa and Tozeur. Dinner and overnight in Tozeur. (BLD)



**TUE DAY 04 TOZEUR-CHOTT EL DJERID-DOUZ** (Optional jeep excursion to mountain oasis) Enjoy lunch in Tozeur and visit the Dar Cheraïet Museum. Depart to Chott El Djerid salt lake. See it shimmer in the sunlight. Continue to Douz – a small Saharan city situated at the door of the Sahara Desert. (Option camel ride). Dinner and overnight in Douz. (BLD)

**WED DAY 05 DOUZ-MATMATA-DJERBA** After breakfast depart to Matmata – the famous Berber village. Visit an underground troglodyte home. Lunch in a local restaurant in Matmata. Continue to Djerba and pass the Ghriba, one of the oldest synagogues in the world. See the Houmt Souk where you will have the opportunity to discover its unique activities such as weaving and saddle-making. There is time to shop! Dinner and overnight Djerba. (BLD)

**THU DAY 06 DJERBA-GABES-SFAX-EL JEM-SOUSSE** Following breakfast depart Djerba for Gabes, a picturesque town where the palm trees actually sweep down to the ocean. Visit the spice market and take in the aromas. Continue to Sfax where you stop for lunch. Travel on to El Jem and visit the imposing amphitheatre, one of the best preserved Roman monuments in Tunisia. Drive on to Sousse for dinner and overnight. Dinner and overnight in Sousse. (BLD)

**FRI DAY 07 SOUSSE-HAMMAMET** Visit Monastir and Sousse in the morning. Have lunch at Kantaoui. Enroute to Hammamet make a stop to see the lovely pottery in Nabeul. Dinner and overnight in Hammamet. (BLD)

**SAT DAY 08 DEPART TUNIS** Please check out of your hotel and you shall be transferred to Tunis airport for your onward flight. (B)

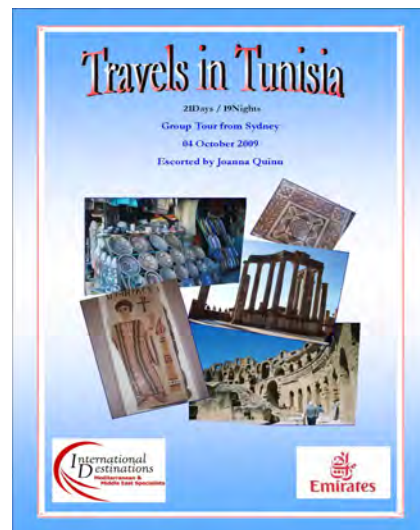

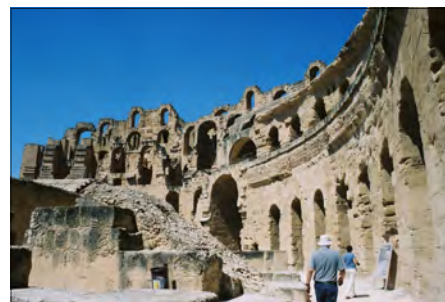

## BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**RESERVATIONS** A deposit of \$330.00 per person (or that requested by principal) required at the time of booking. Payment of deposit signifies acceptance of the terms and conditions. Passenger names must be booked exactly as appears in passport.

**BAGGAGE** The free baggage allowance on the flights is restricted to 20kgs per person and, whilst on tour, one bag per person.

**CANCELLATIONS & OTHER FEES** Cancellations of firm bookings will incur an administration fee (minimum \$55.00 per person or more if required by principal). Cancellations received within 6 weeks of departure date will be subject to a \$330.00 per person service fee plus any charges imposed by principals involved in operating the tour. Once travel has commenced, refunds will not be forthcoming if a service is not used because of late arrival, early departure or passengers choice. 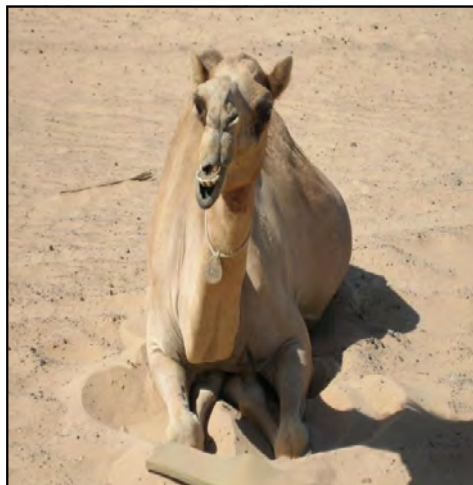
**PASSPORT & VISA** It is necessary for all passengers to be in possession of a valid passport with at least six months validity remaining from last country visited.
